Dear Resident,

We're writing to let you know about upcoming work on Leeman Road on the weekend of **12-13 November 2022**.

Leeman Road footbridge removal

As part of our work in preparing for future upgrades at the Leeman Road junction, we'll be removing the stepped footbridge that crosses Leeman Road between the National Railway Museum (NRM) and the Leeman Road Marble Arch tunnel.

Alternative routes

For safe step free access across Leeman Road there are two nearby locations with a dropped curb and pedestrian island:

- 4 minutes walk to the west of the footbridge location, outside the NRM car park.
- 3 minutes walk to the east of the footbridge location, outside the Royal Mail York Delivery Centre.

To reduce disruption to traffic, we'll remove the footbridge in two overnight shifts across Saturday 12 November and Sunday 13 November. Pedestrians and cyclists will have access to the Marble Arch tunnel throughout and will be diverted around the work site. The area will have clear signs directing pedestrians and cyclists and will be well lit for safety.

Saturday 12 November: The junction will close from 11.16pm, after the last bus comes through Marble Arch. For vehicles, there will be a signed diversion around by Water End and Bootham.

Sunday 13 November: In the morning all diversions will be removed, and the junction reopened by 7.00am. The morning buses through the Marble Arch tunnel won't be affected by the overnight closure.

In the evening the junction will close again at 8.00pm. The No 2A bus will be diverted, with the last No 2A going through at approximately 7.50pm. For vehicles, there will be a signed diversion around by Water End and Bootham.

Monday 14 November: All diversions will be removed, and the junction reopened by 6.00am.
